

Can outdoor power supplies be checked in for class transportation



Overview

UL 1310 covers Class 2 battery chargers and power supplies intended for both indoor and outdoor use. The requirements in the standard apply to cord-connected and direct plug-in products with a maximum input power of 660W. Aerosol insecticides are not allowed in carry-on; however they are allowed in checked bags as long as they are not labeled as hazardous material (HAZMAT). Please check with your airline for any size or weight restrictions. You may. All electrical equipment must be listed and labeled. Temporary wiring methods shall be acceptable only if approved, based on the conditions. Can I bring a powerless device on a plane?
