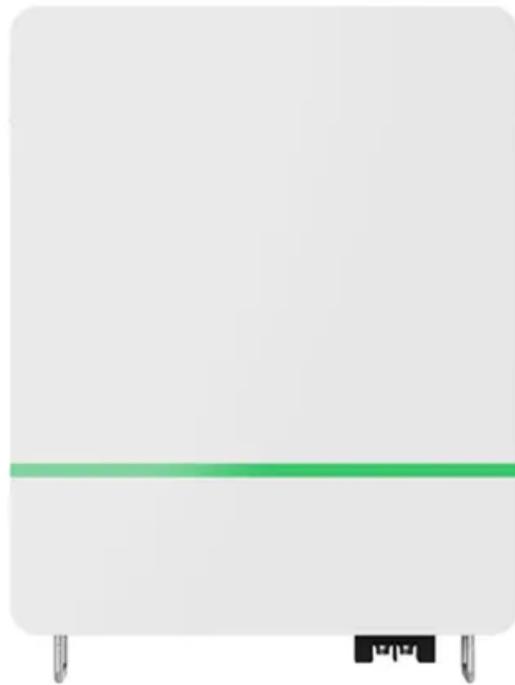


Can turtles be placed in supermarket lockers



Overview

They need a lot of space to move around and should be housed in a watertight, well-ventilated glass or plastic enclosure. The enclosure should include a dry, elevated spot for basking, easily accessible from the water. The water depth should be approximately one and a half to two times the length. Learn why it's ok to release native turtles back into local water, but pet store turtles should stay in your tank. If you catch a baby turtle in local waters, you can raise him until he gets bigger and release him back into those same local waters. Do NOT release pet store turtles into local. Pet turtles are fun and unique companions. Turtles have a relatively long lifetime compared to a cat or dog, and it's important to keep your turtle's care at the highest level possible so they can reach such an advanced age. Keeping the tank clear of these dangers is vital for their well-being.
