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Peel Slowly at 45 Degrees - Pull the plastic back on itself at a 45-degree angle. Clean Any Leftover Adhesive - Spray isopropyl alcohol on any sticky spots. If not, gently lift a corner with your fingernail. I'd wear a giant hat and sunscreen too. Use a hair dryer to.
