

Latest policy on rooftop photovoltaic panel installation



Overview

This article provides a technical yet accessible overview of 10 key policies that require or encourage installing solar panels in new buildings, illustrating how these measures function and their practical impacts. Permitting and inspection are required before a solar array is allowed to produce electricity on the grid. Generally, local governments require solar installers to obtain a permit for rooftop panels before they can be installed. Since the 2016 edition of NFPA 1, access pathways have been required on roofs to facilitate fire service access as well as egress. These government policies for solar panel integration aim to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, lower energy costs, and promote energy independence.

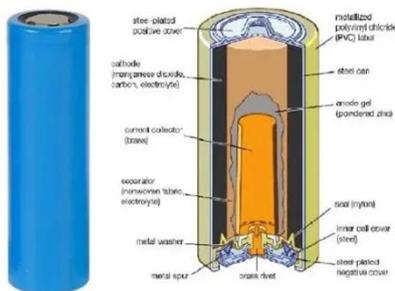



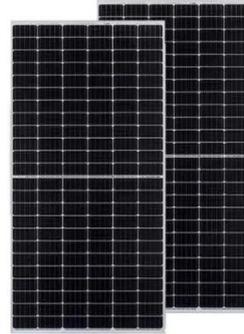
